

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
VALLEY REGIONAL TRANSIT – DISPOSAL OF ASSETS**

Valley Regional Transit (VRT), the regional public transit authority for Ada and Canyon counties, intends to donate, sell or scrap surplus assets and equipment, including but not limited to buses, service and support vehicles, and office equipment. The vehicles are beyond their useful life as determined by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) or too costly to maintain. Other items are obsolete or not required for current operations.

Notice is hereby given that public comment is being sought regarding the disposition of these assets. A public hearing will be held during the VRT Board of Directors meeting on Monday, August 12, 2024, at the VRT administrative offices (700 NE 2<sup>nd</sup> St., Meridian, ID 83642) at 12 p.m. or as soon as possible thereafter.
